Covid-19 Pandemic Phase 1 Restrictions for Re-Opening

General Guidelines

Rink capacity will be reduced in accordance to state guidelines
Customers and staff are required to follow CDC and CT State COVID-19 health guidelines
There will be designated entrance and exit doors
All customers must wear masks
All employees will wear masks and gloves.
Social distancing is required by customers and staff
All employees and customers must remain home if sick
Customers and staff are required to wash hand often
Offering individual-based programming
No lingering in common areas
Water fountains will be closed, please bring your own water
No spitting
No trash thrown on the benches or in the changing areas
Guests over the age of 10 will be required to wear a face mask (exceptions for hockey).
Only one parent will be allowed per child for all activities.
Adding marked seating on player benches to enforce social distancing.
Use of showers prohibited
No Open Hockey, or Sticktime. Ice will be available for Private Hockey Lessons
No public skate
No Learn to Skate
Snack Bar will be closed
Locker rooms will be closed, customers are encouraged to dress prior to arrival at the rink
Hockey games and league play will not be permitted at this time.
Customers will have to pre register and pay for all events
Coaches will have to pre register for all events and provide proof of insurance
Customers will have to sign waiver and health questionnaire every day

Cleaning

Increase cleaning intervals to ensure a safe environment.
Athletic areas will have limited capacity per state guidelines.
Congregating in common areas will not be allowed (lobby and snack bar seating area and outdoors).
Disinfect doors, handles, light switches, keyboards, telephones, handrails, point-of-sale systems, faucets, and restroom dispensers 3 to 4 times daily.
Disinfect between uses and record it in a time log.
Staff has been instructed to wash their hands for at least 20 seconds with soap and water frequently throughout the day, especially at the beginning of their shift, prior to meals and after using the restroom.
Face masks and gloves will be required for all employees cleaning and coming in contact with the public

Hockey Lessons/Figure Skating Lessons

Customers will be allowed entry to the building 10 minutes prior to their ice rental time and will be required to exit 10 minutes after their rental.
Customers should arrive dressed, so they can just put their skates, helmets and gloves on inside the rink.
Avoid utilizing benches
Limited spectators will be allowed in the building.
Reduce physical closeness of skaters.
Players not actively participating must maintain 6 feet of distance from one another along the boards.
Face coverings worn by coaches, sports staff, officials, parents, and spectators.
Customers will have to pre register and pay for all events
Coaches will have to pre register for all events and provide proof of insurance

Changing Areas/Locker Rooms

LOCKER ROOMS ARE OPEN.

PLEASE BE MINDFUL OF THE 6 FEET SOCIAL DISTANCING IN THE LOCKER ROOM; IF NEED BE, A TEAM MAY USE MORE THAN ONE LOCKER ROOM.

PLAYERS MUST WEAR MASKS UNTIL THEIR HELMETS ARE ON. ONCE HELMETS ARE REMOVED AFTER ICE TIME, MASKS MUST BE REAPPLIED.

ONE COACH MUST BE REMAIN IN THE LOCKER ROOM AT ALL TIMES. IF A COACH IS UNAVAILABLE, A SAFESPORT CERTIFIED TEAM MANAGER OR VOLUNTEER MUST REMAIN IN THE LOCKER ROOM.

PLEASE MAKE SURE YOUR PLAYER HAS A WATER BOTTLE FOR THE GAME.

Spectators

One spectator is allowed in the rink per player. **NO SIBLINGS.**

Balconies are available for watching games and marked appropriately.

There are a few marked areas around the boards for spectators as well.
